EXTRA TIPS

- 1. Limit your distractions before and while flying. (Tell people that walk up to you that you will answer all of their questions as soon as you land...and that your battery is low! ©)
- 2. Acquire more than one UAV battery for your drone! (Will help a lot when training.)
- 3. Invest in a folding table or create a cheap platform out of <u>foam poster board</u>!
- 4. Shoot at 30fps and slow this down to 24fps for your videos. It will give the footage a smoother feel.
- 5. Check the K-Index before you fly each day and don't try to break a distance record on days with higher values!
- 6. Keep a <u>Silica Packet</u> in your UAV case to absorb any moisture that might be on your drone. (Get them free out of other packaging!)
